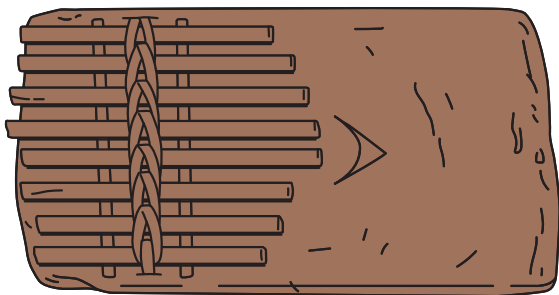


ASOLOGUN

Asologun (lamellophones) were used mainly for entertainment and either played solo or with other lamellophones to accompany storytelling or dances. They are also known as thumb pianos or sansas, and are a kind of musical instrument made and used by people across the African continent, and specific to Benin, it is a small wooden box with metal lengths fastened to the top by horizontally placed bars.
