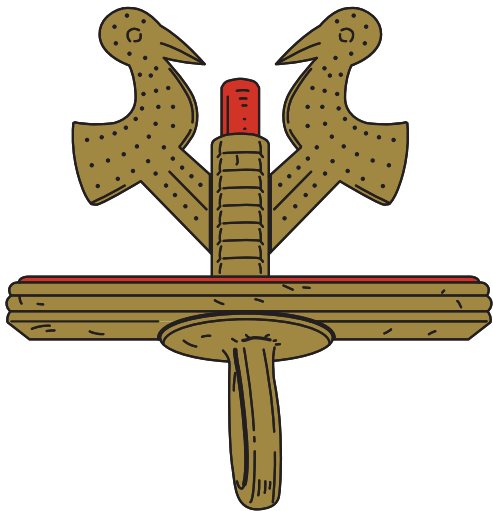


OROKA

Oroka (finger rings) were often worn as amulets of protection. Priests or diviners affiliated with different deities may bless Oroka for different purposes, such as protection of the wearer. There are a number of simpler forms, without coral, that may have been worn by women of the royal court.
